James Emery White is the founding and senior pastor of Mecklenburg Community Church (Meck) in Charlotte, NC. Mecklenburg Community Church (Meck) began with a single family and has grown to more than 20,000 active attenders through in-person and online campuses.

Meck also experiences more than 70% of its growth from those who were previously unchurched. Dr. White is the president of Serious Times, a ministry that explores the intersection offaith and culture and hosts churchandculture.org featuring his blog and a wide range of resources to serve the church. He is a former professor of theology and culture at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, where he also served as their fourth president. Dr. White is an author of more than twenty books that have been translated into ten languages. Among his many books are Gold Medallion nominees Serious Times and A Search for the Spiritual. His most recent releases are Christianity for People Who Aren't Christians: Uncommon Answers to Common Questions, its companion titled After "I Believe": Everyday Practices for a Vibrant Faith, and his latest book Hybrid Church: Rethinking the Church for a Post-Christian Digital Age. # "Compassionate Clarity on Humans as Male & Female"

## Morning Workshop-11am; Afternoon Workshop-3:30pm

Most pastors have counseled someone with gender dysphoria or someone concerned about a loved one with gender dysphoria. This workshop will cover 2 steps: (1) It will walk participants through a discernment process, seeking to redefine "gender dysphoria" in theological-biblical terms. (2) Participants will review a proposed set of new Q&As relating to maleness and femaleness as a supplement to the EA's historic catechisms (Evangelical & Heidelberg Catechisms). Be equipped to set aside surface-level approaches to gender and dig instead for the treasure, which is God's renewed image in each person.

#### **Workshop Presenter: Pastor Andrew Keuer**



Pastor Andrew is married to Lydia, and they have five children, ages 11 to 4. Andrew is Senior Minister of First Protestant Church of New Braunfels, TX, and previously pastored a rural EA congregation in the College Station area. He wrote his doctoral thesis on St. Augustine's theology of

sexuality and gender at University of Aberdeen and was Professor of Theology & Ethics at the Evangelical Theological College in Athens, Greece for nine years.
